Duty Boat – Race Officer tasks

1. Select course for the race
2. Arrive at start box 5.00pm
 - a. Display course number
 - b. Record boats arriving at start area
3. Monitor VHF channel 77 in pre-start and during race
4. Start race
 - a. Auto start box set-up just press the start button at 1755 and the sound signals and lights will be managed automatically
5. Watch start line for any premature starters.
 - a. If any;
 - i. If you can identify individual boats - Press the **Individual Recall** button. If possible, notify boats on channel 77. Record if they recrossed correctly.
 - ii. If many boats are early and you cannot identify individual boats – Press the **General Recall** button. After two minutes commence a new start sequence.
6. Record finish times in 24-hour format on sheet.
7. Enjoy two complimentary drinks from the bar to thank you for your service 😊

There are instructions and guidelines waiting for you in the start box.

If you cannot find a boat representative to complete your duty there are a few volunteers in the club who will take your turn, but you need to contact them and request this early.
